Murphy Rebel Reborn: Continental XO-340 Titan Drives 176-HP Performance

Congratulations to Timothy Fiedler, the winner of our August Murphy Aircraft Around the World! Tim's Murphy Rebel is a standout example of how creativity and engineering can transform a classic kitplane into a true backcountry performer.

Tim began his search for the ultimate STOL aircraft years ago, eventually discovering a carefully crafted Rebel whose history stretches back to 1991. Instead of stopping with the aircraft's already-impressive workmanship, he set out to give it new life—upgrading nearly every system and creating what he calls a "super-STOL."



The most striking change is under the cowl: a Continental XO-340 Titan engine producing 176 horsepower. Most Rebels fly happily with a 150-horsepower Lycoming O-320, but Tim wanted extra muscle for Idaho's high-density-altitude strips. The Titan delivers exceptional climb rates, shorter takeoff rolls (as little as 180 feet at full gross), and the flexibility to burn automotive fuel thanks to its low-compression design.



Tim's upgrades didn't stop there. The Rebel now features a custom Catto three-blade composite propeller, a modern Advanced Flight Systems panel with a 10" glass display, ADS-B In/Out, a fully coupled three-axis autopilot, and carefully tuned electric flaps and trim. The result is an aircraft that cruises at 125 mph, stalls near 31 knots, and offers comfort and capability for serious backcountry adventures.

"My goal in using the XO-340 Titan and Catto prop combination was to keep the completed aircraft as light as possible, maximize available power, and minimize the weight on the nose. The cost of all this fun was not my top consideration." Tim says.

Tim's story shows that Murphy builders have choices beyond the traditional Lycoming route, and that the Continental Titan series is a proven alternative for pilots who want extra performance without sacrificing reliability.
